

General Forestry Learnership Programme 2012



Applications are invited from candidates who wish to pursue a career in Forestry. The suitable candidates will be granted an opportunity to attend a one year General Forestry Learnership Programme prior to formal tertiary studies. The Learnership duration is 12 months; the learners will be studying and residing at our Platorand Training Centre situated in Sabie in the Mpumalanga Province to complete both the theoretical and practical component of the Learnership.

Learners will receive a monthly stipend for the duration of the learnership. Candidates who successfully complete this programme will receive a General Education and Training Certificate in General Forestry and may be granted bursaries by the Fibre Processing and Manufacturing SETA to study towards a Forestry BSc Degree or National Diploma in Forestry / Wood Technology at the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University or Stellenbosch University in 2013.

Requirements

- Grade 12 with Mathematics, Biology and Science passed
- Must have a passion for the environment and be able to work outdoors.
